As we come into the month of February when love is in the air and us old codgers try to do something new to let our spouses or kids know just how much they mean to us, why not do the one thing that takes so little effort but means so very, very much: tell them. "Greetings from cold and snowy South Dakota! We enter this new calendar year with great excitement and anticipation. As many of you know, we have been spending the past year or more praying, researching, and exploring to determine the direction God would have us move as a school. It was decided that our school, Oyate Concern Christian School, should separate organizationally from Oyate Concern Ministries to become or own nonprofit entity.

Oyate Hope Academy (O.H.A.) is our new name. While we have a name, until the IRS grants us a tax-exempt status, **all donations to the school still need to go through Oyate Concern.**

As a newly formed nonprofit organization, we are in the process of developing a board of directors to provide us with structure, accountability, and guidance. The number of decisions that need to be made in the next several months seems overwhelming at times, but we know that God is in control and we will continue to trust Him in His timing. NO OTHER GOSPEL: A NEW TEACHING SERIES FROM DEREK THOMAS BEGINNING SUNDAY, FEBRUARY 14TH AT 8:30 AM WITH PASTOR DAVID — IN THE FIRESIDE ROOM

If you get the gospel wrong, you get everything wrong. In first-century Galatia, false teachers infiltrated the church, claiming that faith in Jesus Christ is not enough to be justified in God's sight. Responding to this distortion of the gospel, the Apostle Paul wrote a passionate letter defending the doctrine of justification by faith alone, for he knew what was truly at stake. In this <u>new video teaching series</u>, <u>Dr. Derek Thomas</u> walks us through the background, teaching, and importance of Paul's letter to the Galatians. While false gospels drive people to despair, the true gospel frees us to rest in Christ alone for our Salvation.


