Now I know many of you are thinking I misread my calendar this morning, but I can assure you I have not. In the life of the church we are about to celebrate the beginning of a new year. The first Sunday of Advent is the beginning of a new *church* year.

On Sunday, December 2nd we will light the first candle of the Advent wreath. As we begin this four-week period of preparation for the birth of Jesus, during these days we are encouraged to make room in our hearts and lives for the coming of God's son, our Savior. This is an opportunity for us to examine our lives or as the prophet Isaiah says, it is a time for us to prepare in the deserts of lives “a highway for our God.” Advent provides a time for us to examine how we live as disciples of Jesus Christ, to fill in the valleys and smooth out the rough places so we might open our hearts and lives for God to be truly present. There is no doubt we will all be very busy preparing and practicing making each of these special events uplifting and successful. During this Season of Advent, I pray each of you will take a few moments each day in the midst of preparations to pause, pray, and ponder the great mystery of God appearing in the manger of Bethlehem as a helpless infant, who will be the salvation of all. Instead of getting lost in all the outside influences of society, may you find yourselves in the mystery of God's incarnation.

It is a great privilege to be with you during this season in the life of the church, and on behalf of my family, I want to wish you and your families a holy Advent and a very Merry Christmas.

With colors soft or bold.

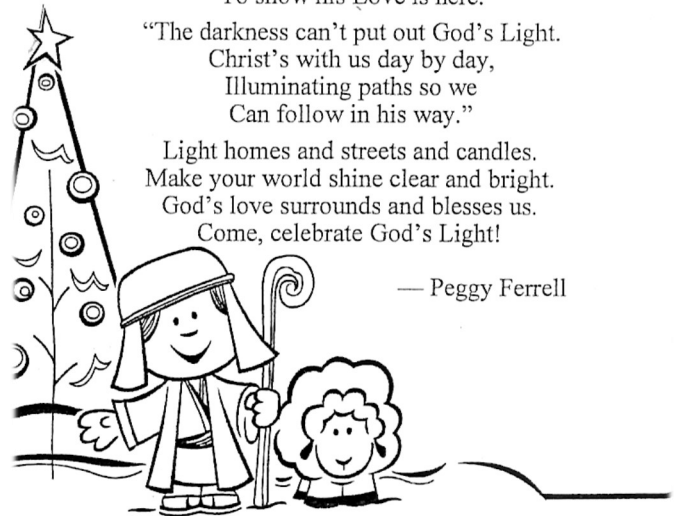
Cascading from the rooftops,
