The class is entitled *The Parables of Jesus*. This is a 12 Week DVD-Based series that includes a work along study guide. The author is absolutely my favorite theologian of the past 50 years: R.C. Sproul. I cannot tell you how much Dr. Sproul's teaching has personally influenced my own understanding of the Christian Scriptures, Christian life as well as the Reformed tradition. So, if you have a hunger to grow deeper in your Spiritual walk and are thirsting for great, biblical teaching concerning 12 parables that our precious Lord shared throughout His ministry, please plan on joining myself and others on Sunday, July 14<sup>th</sup> for our initial class.

In closing, let me again say, how glad we are to be here. And here is a bit of trivia you may find interesting. In the New Testament, we have the 4 Gospel books, followed by an account of the first Apostles. Next are the 13, Pauline Epistles written by, well...the Apostle Paul. The coffee book of Hebrews is followed by what we call the 7 General Epistles. The New Testament canon ends with the prophetic book of Revelation. 27 books. Let me ask you..., how are the Pauline Epistles arranged. Here are your choices: Alphabetically? Chronologically? In order of the early church's perception of importance? Length? Well, believe it or not, the letters of Paul are arranged in our bibles from longest (Romans) to shortest (Philemon). Humm, thought there would be a more spiritual explanation. Nope...Just a matter of length.

### **THE HISTORIC "COMMUNITY ROOMS"**


Looking ahead to The United Churches Centennial Celebration in 2020, we are beginning the process of planning the Centennial Celebration Booklet.
